

Alice K. Boatwright

Alice K. Boatwright is most widely known today for her popular Ellie Kent mysteries. The first in this series of traditional mysteries, *UNDER AN ENGLISH HEAVEN*, won the 2016 Mystery and Mayhem Grand Prize for best mystery; and the sequel, *WHAT CHILD IS THIS?* was published in November 2017. The third book will be published in 2019.

Alice began her writing career with literary fiction, and her first book, *COLLATERAL DAMAGE*, traces the impact of the Vietnam War on those who fought, those who resisted, and the families and friends caught in between. It was a finalist for the Flannery O'Connor Award for Short Fiction and won the Independent Publisher Book Awards bronze medal for literary fiction in 2013.

In 2019, she published *SEA, SKY, ISLANDS*, a chapbook of stories and art, and she has published dozens of short stories in journals such as the *Mississippi Review*, *Stone Canoe*, *Storyglossia*, and *CALYX*.

Raised on the East Coast, Alice was a longtime resident in the Bay Area, before moving to Europe, where she lived in England and France for a decade. Since 2014, she has made her home north of Seattle.
